Phillis Wheatley - Poet - Biography Phillis Wheatley was an African American poet and slave. She wrote Poems on Various Subjects, Religious and Moral, making her the first African American and first slave to publish a volume of poetry. Phillis Wheatley - Slave Poet of Colonial America The American Revolution intervned in Phillis Wheatley's career, and the effect was not completely positive. The people of Boston -- and of America and England -- bought books on other topics rather than the volume of Phillis Wheatley poems.
